All applications to the First Year Group or the Designated ASD Unit (for ALL year groups) in Coláiste Íde agus losef will only be accepted after the 9th October 2024 and the closing date for receipt of applications is the 6th December 2024. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

All transfer applications to the Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth or Sixth Year Groups in Coláiste Íde agus Iosef other than to the Designated ASD Unit, will only be accepted after the 9th October 2024 and the closing date for receipt

of applications is the <u>6th December 2024</u>. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

Please be reminded that, in line with the school's Admission Policy and the Education (Admission to Schools) Act 2018, all waiting lists going forward are only in place for the academic year to which they apply. Therefore, if a student is seeking a place in the Designated ASD Unit and is not successful in a given academic year or is on a waiting list for this year, a new application must be made for the following year.

This school will cooperate with the National Council for Special Education in the performance by the Council of its functions under the Education for Persons with Special Educational Needs Act 2004 relating to the provision of education to children with special educational needs, including in particular by the provision and operation of a special class or classes when requested to do so by the Council.

This school will comply with any direction served on the patron or the board, as the case may be, under section 37A and any direction served on the board under section 67(4B) of the Education Act.
